## **Dress Code Update**

We are off to a great 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, but we have noticed that some are not adhering to the Uniform Policy set forth by the Day School Committee. Please note the following items, and please take the opportunity this week to take the steps needed to stay within the bounds of the policies that we expect at TLS:

- Grades 4-8, black or brown belts must be worn if pants have belt loops
- Visible socks must be a solid color: red, white, navy, or black
- Shirts must be fully tucked in; front and back
- Uniform pants/slacks (skinny pants are NOT acceptable)
- Hair must be kept in its natural color
- Boy's hair shall be worn so it's not to touch the shirt collar or the eye brows
- Students are not allowed to have any marking or drawings to suggest a tattoo
- No jogger pants (elastic at the ankles)
